We have enjoyed watching the leaves changing all around us. This time of the year is always so gorgeous. As we see the changing of the season I am reminded of Daniel 2:20-23 where Daniel is rejoicing that he received an answer to his prayers.

When we were doing the application for Moriah's birth certificate, they said it could take 1 to 3 months for the office to get this done depending on their staffing because of Covid. We are coming up on the 3 months very soon. Please continue to pray that we will receive this very important document so we can start the process for her Passport and then Visas to enter Madagascar. Waiting can be hard because we don't know how long it will be and we don't want to get "settled in" in America. It will be so good to be in a place where, Lord willing, we can call "home" for a little while and not live with the anticipation of packing and leaving.

While we are waiting to be able to go to Madagascar, we have been busy. We have been visiting our neighbors and giving them tracts and the gospel. We are trying to visit everyone in the neighborhoods around us before it is time for us to leave. We have been able to have some good contacts with those around us. When I think about the greatness of what Jesus did for us on the cross in giving His life for our sins and how He rose again – all to make a way for us to have a relationship with Him, I want to share this wonderful news with all the lost! It is hard to see people who are not saved and don't care about God! There are many people in Madagascar who NEED to hear the gospel and get saved, but there are also many people here in our neighborhood who NEED the gospel too! Please pray for us not to lose sight of what is important – giving the gospel to those all around us. We all need to be careful not to get distracted by the world and the cares of the world. Jesus spent His life caring for the souls of people; I am called to imitate Christ and do the same!
